Important school closure information

I am writing to provide you with important information regarding two upcoming school closures:

1. **Friday 23rd September** – As per our published calendar on our website which was also shared with you last term, Kings Meadow School is closed on Friday 23rd September for a staff-training day. This has been agreed with West Northamptonshire Council in order to provide some important professional development for the staff early in the academic year and enable them to improve further the way they support the children in school.
2. **Monday 19th September** – As I am sure you are aware, the government has announced that Monday 19th September will be a Bank Holiday to mark the funeral of our late Queen, Elizabeth II. We are aware that this has fallen in the same week as our scheduled training day.

Although we could not have predicted this when the annual calendar was planned, we do recognise that it is not ideal for the children to have two days of closures in the same week. Unfortunately, we are unable to rearrange our training day due to confirmed bookings with external trainers. We apologise for any inconvenience caused during the week commencing 19th September. Children will be provided with some suggested activities by their class teachers which you may wish to undertake with them.
