Furthermore as **designers** we will look at sleeping bags in order to design and make our own mini-sleeping bags to suit a mountaineer. Finally as **scientists**, we will observe and investigate different rocks and soils and consider their different properties.



In Maths this term as well as meeting our individual maths targets, we will also be improving our skills and knowledge of position and direction, subtraction and 3D shape.



As detectives we will start the term by checking for evidence of dragons and will then learn how to trap a dragon in order to create our own set of dragon-inspired instructions.



In PE this term, as well as strengthening our bodies and improving our co-ordination and balance in Real PE. Hedgerow Class will also be learning cricket skills.



In RE this term, we will be learning about the key aspects of Christianity and considering people who inspire us.
